We carried out an 'outstanding' installation at Chauncy Secondary School in Ware, just weeks before the school itself was rated 'Outstanding' by Ofsted.

Our team supplied and installed a mix of PVC-U windows, plastisol steel panels and aluminium windows and modular screening to large parts of the 1980s building. The primary aim of the project was to reduce energy costs, but also to deliver a stylish new makeover.

Our solution delivered not only a modern and stylish makeover but one that is hard wearing and low maintenance.

Working to a tight schedule while the school was closed to students during the Summer break, we used the Shopline modular screening system from Smarts because it could be assembled rapidly onsite
